### County Councillor's Report

Cllr Batters read out his report for 2017/18 which included information about the roadworks schedule, a historical note about the Highways Act of 1555, which was very interesting, and a request to keep reporting any potholes as soon as possible.

### The A30

Steve Wood from Cornwall Council attended and gave an update on the A30 – there are still some works to carry out by Kier but all should be completed by the end of June. Millpool Signage was discussed and it can be noted that THE Preeze Cross sign will have both Millpool and Cardinham on it. The narrow passing place on the corner at entry/exit of Millpool is a cause for concern. Other concerns raised were:

Cattle crossing – the informal crossing is still open. Highways England are in discussion with the relevant groups.

Mountain of earth will be moved shortly

The deceleration lane by the bridge is too short.

Require regular maintenance of Lidcutt junction to maintain visibility

The Chair thanked Steve Wood for his attendance and for the additional information which was most helpful.

Steve Wood, Cllr C Batters and several parishioners then left the meeting.
